**Q: How should I dress for the party? Is there a strict dress code?**

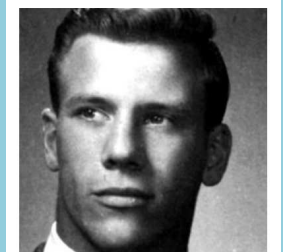
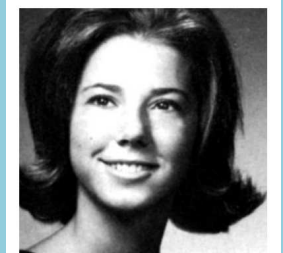
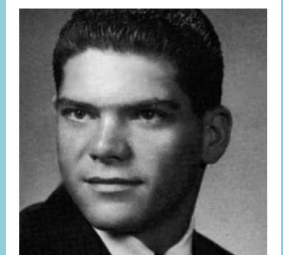

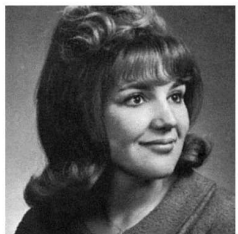
**Q: If I want to purchase additional items at the party, can you charge my credit card?**
