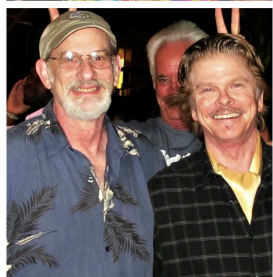
And for these teachers, it's a chance to share your joys and to hear (first hand from you) about your lives since you left them in the classroom and went on into the world of careers, family and adventures.

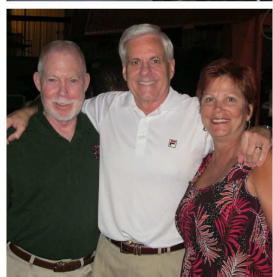
