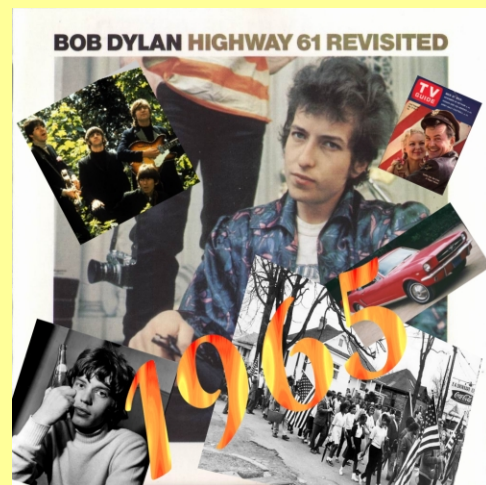
## It's Been 50 Years Since We Graduated. How Have We Changed?
