- A: The Sheraton Agoura Hills Resort Hotel is located at 30100 Agoura Road in Agoura Hills. It is just 1 minute off the Reyes Adobe Road off-ramp of the 101 Freeway. Exact directions are on the website (<u>www.gchs65.com</u>) and easily obtained via Google Maps.

### **Q:** Do I have to pay for parking?

A: No, although valet parking is also available.

### Q: What time should I arrive?

A: Registration and a light reception start promptly at 5:00 and the doors to the ballroom open precisely at 6:00pm. Try to arrive before 5:00.
